WORKSHOP A: Needlework with Michele Roberts



"Stitching the Scriptures" is an embroidery workshop on how to create beautiful Christian ornaments suitable for hanging as an ornament, each of which bears a familiar motto from the New Testament and a golden charm to remind us. Choose one from the following list:

"He is Risen" (butterfly), "I am the True Vine" (grape cluster), "Jesus Christ is Lord" (golden crown), "Keep Calm and Pray on" (silver crown), "King of Kings" (golden crown), "Prince of Peace" (golden crown), or "To Everything there is a Season" (Celtic cross). Also available is a brocade ornament kit with an elaborate gold cross pendant, or a cross stitch pattern of the Episcopal shield.

Learn how to finish over padded mat boards with gold cords and how to do a custom beaded edge. Kits include: chart and instructions, white even-weave embroidery fabric, embroidery threads, the gold charm, padding, mat boards, fabric backing, gold cord, gold braid, beads, lacing thread, and needles. Bring embroidery scissors and a pencil. (It isn't necessary to bring frames, as we will be working in hand. Bring additional light and magnification if you feel you may need it.) Kit cost for each complete ornament kit: \$20.00 each. Still available: Episcopal Shield cross stitch (history and pattern, fabric, thread): \$5.00
