

FAQs -170th Diocesan Council of the Diocese of Texas

- 1) **Emergency:** In the event of an emergency, call 911. Please also notify Rob Montgomery. He can be reached at 512.789.4585.
- 2) **Election:** The Bishop Suffragan Election will be held on Friday Morning/Afternoon.
- 3) **The Bishop's Address:** The Bishop's Address will take place Saturday afternoon. It will be livestreamed on the Diocesan Facebook page, @texasdiocese.
- 4) **Exhibits:** The Exhibit Hall will be open from 2-5:15 p.m. on February 21, 7 a.m. -5 p.m. on February 22, and 7 a.m.-9 a.m. on February 23.
- 5) **iPads:** All voting will be done electronically via laptops, smartphones and tablets. If you registered as needing an iPad you may check them out each morning and check them back in at the end of each session.
- 6) **Parking:** Free parking is available in the hotel garage (shared with the Cynthia Woods Pavilion.) Park on the 4th floor of the garage and take the skybridge over Six Pines Dr. to the 2nd floor of the hotel, then take the escalator down to the hotel lobby.
- 7) **Vesting:** Clergy are invited to vest for the Eucharist. Please wear red stoles.
- 8) **Choir:** Those who are interested in inging in the choir for the opening Eucharist may attend a choir rehearsal on Thursday, February 21 from 2:15-3:45 p.m. at Town Center North. Please bring your choir robes.
